GUIDELINES

- **We accept donations during open hours only:** Mon-Fri 1-6pm, Sat (1st & 3rd) 9am-2pm.
- **Do not dump items outside of Town Hall.** No items in the book drop please!
- Please notify staff at circulation desk of drop-off.
- Contact us ahead of time if you have more than 4 boxes to deliver.
- All items must be clean & in good, saleable condition without highlighting/writing inside.
- Donated items may be added to the library's collection, sold to raise funds or discarded at the discretion of the Library Director

- Current fiction & nonfiction
- Unabridged audiobook CDs
- DVDs in good condition
