### GENERAL RULES

- Items must be brought to the front desk. No items in the book drop please!
- Please contact us ahead of time if you have more than 2 boxes to deliver.
- All items must be clean and in good condition
- Donated items may be added to the Library's collection, sold to raise funds or discarded at the discretion of the Library Director

### What we usually accept...

- Current hardcover/softcover nonfiction
- Current hardcover/softcover fiction
- Unabridged audiobook CDs
- DVDs in good condition

### What we don't accept...

- Readers Digest Condensed Books
- Encyclopedias & Dictionaries
- Text books
- Moldy, musty or smoky books
- Out-of-date technology or computer books
- Magazines
- Audio or VHS cassettes
- Trade paperbacks
- Highlighted books
- Library Discards

### Other places to donate...

- **The Salvation Army** in Barre will take books in good condition: 802-476-5301
- **The Benefit Shop** in Barre will take books, no more than 20 at a time: 802-479-4309
- **Central Vermont Solid Waste** in Barre will take books for recycling: 1-800-730-9475
- **Listen Community Services** in Lebanon will take books except for library discards, encyclopedias or ones in very poor condition at all four of their locations: 603-448-4553
- **Big Hearted Book Drop** has a big white drop-off bin in the north end of the parking lot of JC Penney's in West Lebanon.
